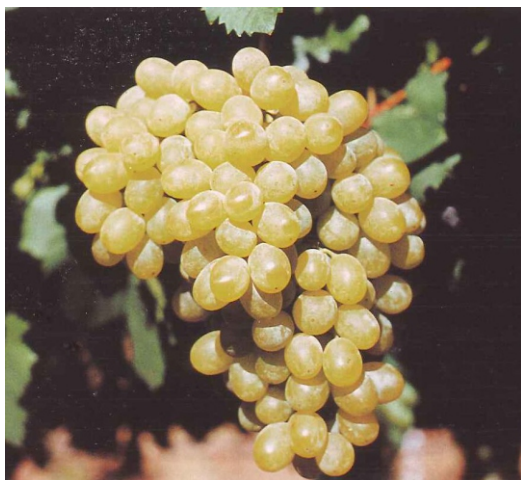


# DAUPHINE



**VARIETY NAME:** Dauphine  
**ORIGIN:** South Africa

*Prune with half-long bearers. Thrives best on medium to heavy soils. Heat damage can sometimes occur on young vines. Reasonable resistance to berry splitting, but neck cracking can occur. Can remain on vine for long time under favourable conditions. Good affinity with known rootstocks.*
